deposit money withdraw money check balance transfer money		more?









Some C++ Background




- Created in 1979 by Bjarne Stroustrup of Bell Labs (home of UNIX and C).
- Added object-oriented features to C.
- Renamed to C++ in honor of auto-increment operator.
- Later standardized with several International
- Organization for Standards (ISO) specifications.
- Greatly influenced Java development (1991).

















- You will use the GL Linux systems and GCC (GNU Compiler Collection) suite for development.
